MISSION

To protect land along the Alder River so it stays farms, forest and open trail for good, and to look after it every year.

PROGRAM 1 · PRESERVES AND TRAILS

Seven preserves owned by the organization and open to the public free, dawn to dusk, with 14 miles of trail. Staff post each preserve's status every morning on the organization's website.

PROGRAM 2 · CONSERVATION EASEMENTS AND STEWARDSHIP

37 conservation easements on 3,480 acres of private farms and forest held at year end; every one was monitored by a site visit during the year.

PROGRAM 3 · COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

Volunteer work days about twice a month and guided walks about thirty times a year.
